

Community & Childcare Options



Every group will handle childcare differently. No one should watch children alone. Since many parents & families come to Restored, every group should plan for children. Here are several options to consider:

- Dedicate one room in the house for childcare.
- Ask teens to watch children - No one should watch children alone. Ask two teens if they would be willing to watch the children.
- Intentionally pair up people to watch children - No one should watch children alone. Have trustworthy group members volunteer to form a rotation. Intentionally pair up two men or two women so they build a relationship while serving together
- Ask parents to bring their children's favorite quiet activities (Books, Toys, Devices, etc.)
- Allow children to participate in the group, and be intentional to include them with encouragement, questions, or prayer.
- One Group, Two Houses - Use the host homes of two families who live close to each other. Have children watched at one house, while adults meet in the other.
- Each family gets their own babysitter.
