

BUILDING PROJECT

In Summer of 2023, we gutted and remodeled 75% of our building to maximize our building as an asset and resource for city impact all throughout the week. We are strategically located in the poorest neighborhood in our city and we love the proximity that provides for us to make the gospel and community accessible for thousands of people living in poverty within walking distance of our building. So rather than designing primarily for Sunday ministry use, we designed it for multipurpose use to maximize our opportunities to love, serve, and reach people who are at-risk and in need throughout the week.
















HUB FOR MOVEMENT

What you've seen reflected in our Annual Report is the fruit of our Hub for Movement strategy at Restored and it's five interconnected components.



CENTRALIZED MINISTRY





CENTRALIZED MINISTRIES

These are ministries that are **directly led & fueled by our church's organizational structure.** Examples of this would be Sunday Gatherings, Community Groups, Restored Kids, Counseling Ministry, etc.

THE TIMOTHY INITIATIVE

In our pursuit of leading & launching a Disciple-Making/Church Planting Movement with The Timothy Initiative, we are multiplying disciple makers, leaders, and churches to the 4th generation.

Ultimately, we want to see a Discovery Bible Study and/or a Micro-Church on every one of the 679 Blocks in Wilkes-Barre.

INTERNSHIPS

We invest in shaping the next generation of leaders as disciple makers, leaders, and church planters by developing and deploying them in the context of relational community and city engagement. We do this by offering **practical**, **residential**, and accredited internships that are uniquely tailored to their passions, gifting, and goals.

REGIONAL COLLABORATION

We work to be a **catalyst for collaboration between regional gospel-centered pastors, leaders, churches, and ministries.** We have weekly rhythms of blessing, encouraging, coaching, resourcing, and praying for other gospel teammates in our city and region.

CITY IMPACT

As a church that is "In the City, For the City", we are heavily invested in making an impact in the tangible needs of our city. We are currently engaged in four key areas: Impacting Poverty, Addressing Food Insecurity, Caring for At-Risk Families & Foster Children, and Engaging in Anti-Human Trafficking Efforts.

ONGOING PARTNERSHIP

Everything happening at Restored is made possible by financial partners both within our church family and beyond our church who generously give external support.

By ministering in an urban context and being a church primarily of and for the poor, that produces a higher volume of needs and a lower threshold of resources. One of the unique realities that produces in our urban church is that the average person/family at Restored Church gives \$20 or less per week, which we know is truly sacrificial for many of our people who are living in low and fixed income situations.

Pursuing funding from both within Restored and external sources gives us the opportunity to invite our members to actively participate, while also gaining access a larger pool of resources. This unique strategy empowers us to execute our vision for city impact with an under-privileged, under-resourced, and under-reached population.

As a church, all sustainability expenses are covered internally by the generous giving of our church. But we've created a funding stream for catalytic investments to help us scale & expand our gospel reach and community development efforts through our City Impact Fund.
